- Attend PCC Fremont Campus part time (tuition and costs paid by the city)
- Learn all facets of police work through college course work and hands on experience
- Become very familiar with CCPD operations by rotating through numerous assignments
- Earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Law Enforcement
- Attend the Pueblo Community College Police Academy paid by the City

You must:

- Be a Cañon City Resident
- Be a Graduate of Cañon City High School (or equivalent)
- Want to become a Police Officer at the age of 21
- Submit with your City of Cañon City Application a 1,000 word essay on "Why you would like to be a Cañon City Police Officer".

Testing Includes:

- Written Test
- Background Investigation
- Oral Board
- Polygraph
- Psychological Test
- Physical Examination
- Drug Test
- Chief's Interview
