





Who We Are and Our Goals

- A centralized housing work group that addresses housing questions, concerns, barriers, and provides assistance.
- A collaboration with housing service partners in Fremont County.
- To identify, combat and find solutions to Fremont County's systematic barriers to affordable housing.
- To create a more harmonious landlord-tenant environment through property management partnership.



Already accomplished in just 4 meetings

- Successfully booked and commenced our first meeting with 2 landlords on April 8th.
- Added additional educational materials to the UAACOG's free Renters Workshop.
- Identified the barriers making it difficult to obtain affordable housing in Fremont County.
- Developing an action plan to combat these barriers.
- Developed and implemented a Renter's Resume to provide landlords with a comprehensive overview of tenant qualifications and personal character.


