

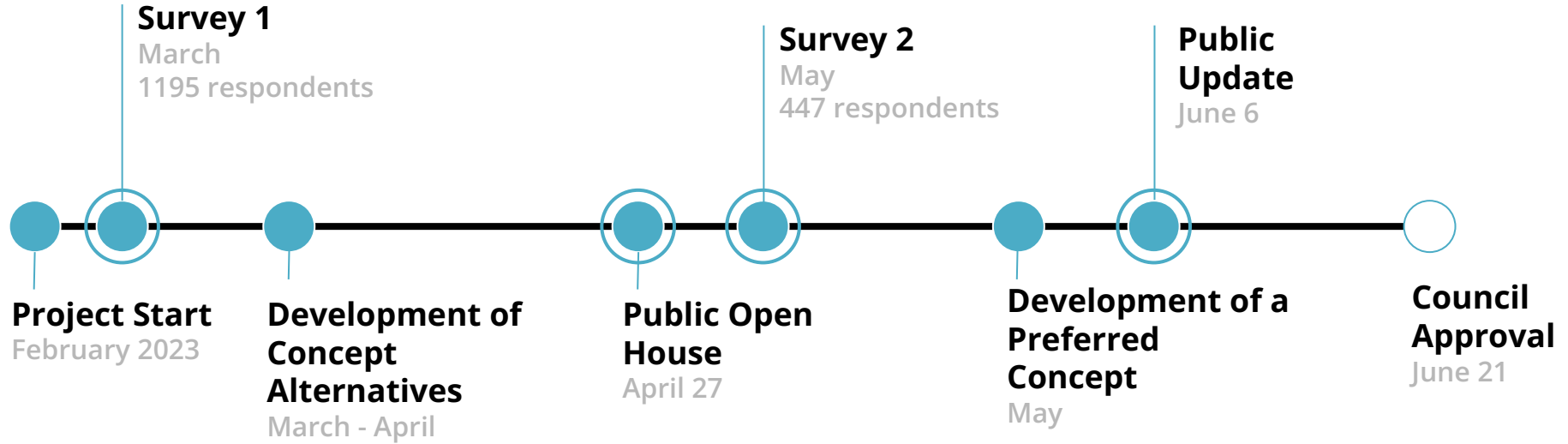

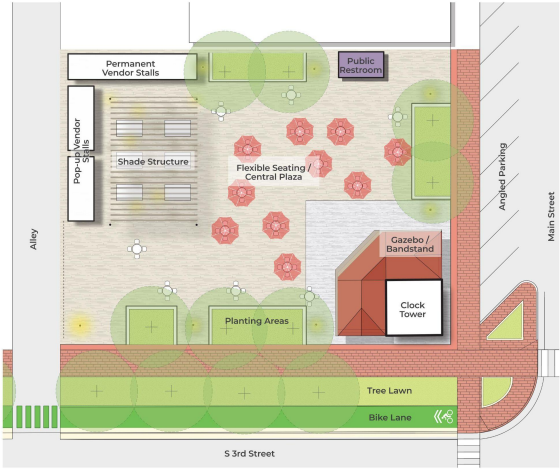

# What We Heard

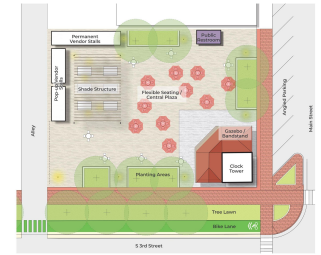
## Top Likes

- Public restroom

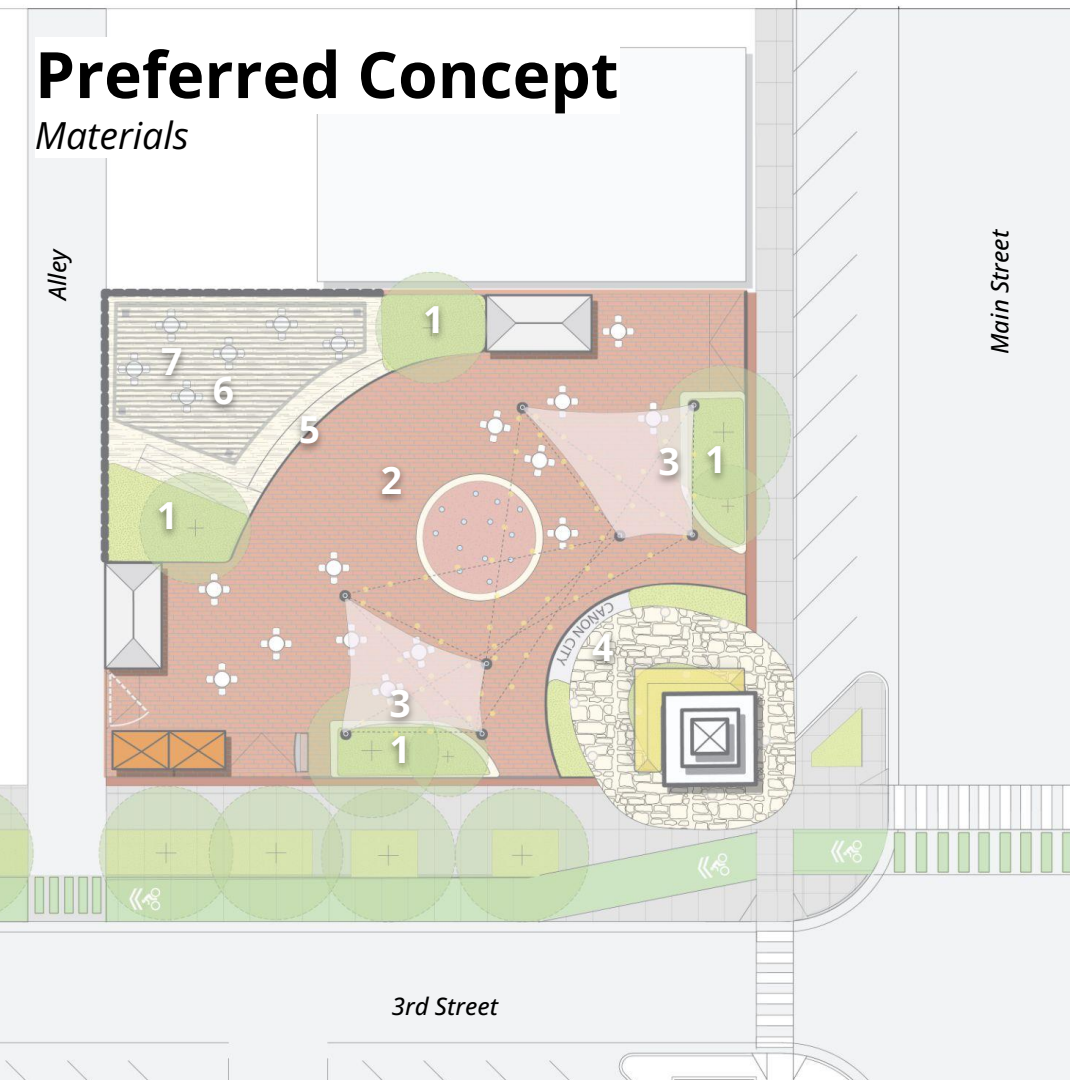

5. Sandstone Slab Terrace

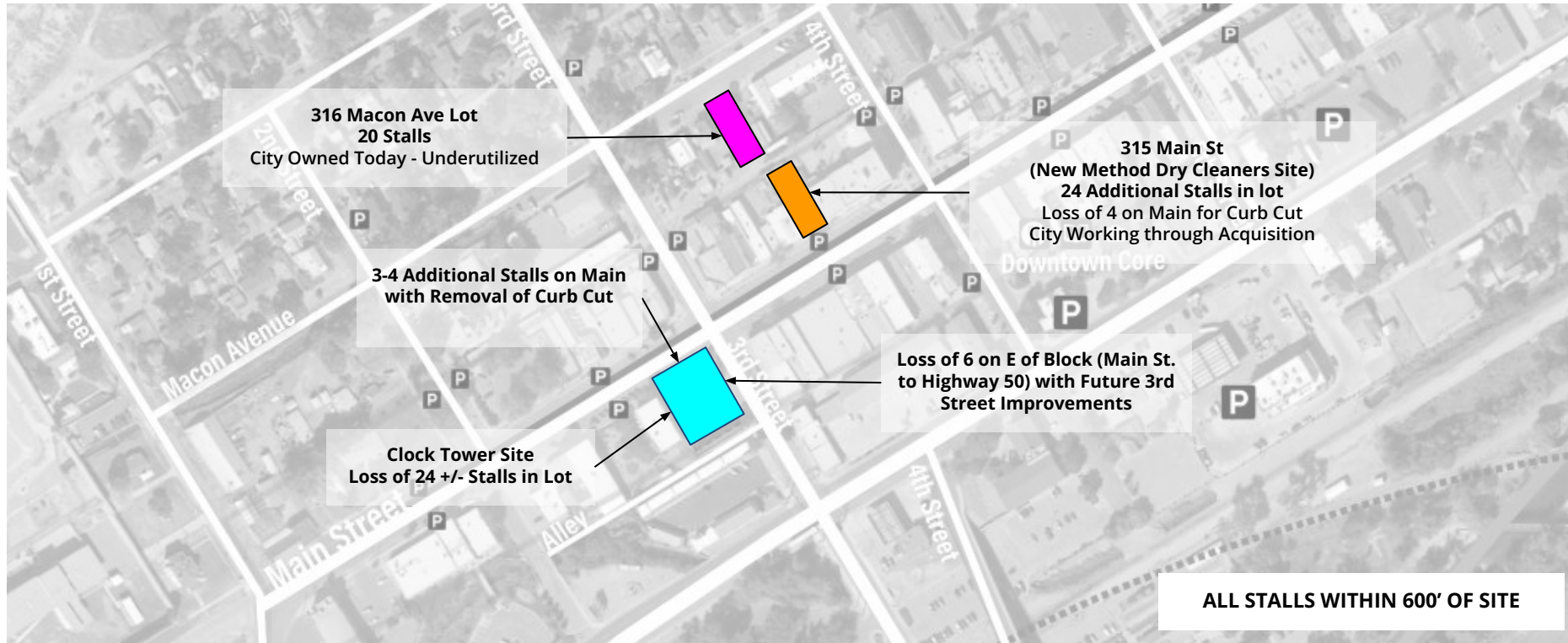
