XIII a few bones not very good

XIV Amph. latus femur from near C.S. ter's in Oberlin my femur came from oil
tract, 1 or 2 miles from above locality from a bed of sandstone near the same
horizon.

The horizon of these bones is nearly identical & is 500 feet above the red beds in
bluish & lead colored marls or white sandstone below a bed of sandstone about 50
feet.

XV Humerus in sections, with a large piece of centrum of caudal vert., upper end
of long bone of oval section in short drain from oil tract a mile below the A. latus
loc.

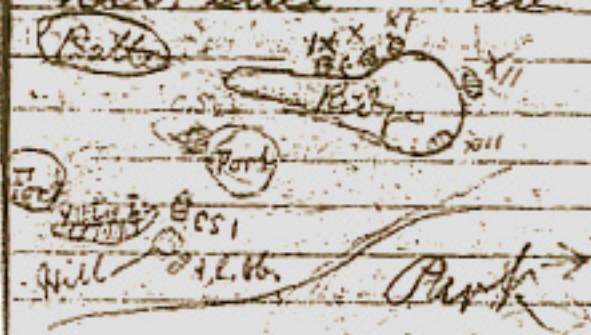
