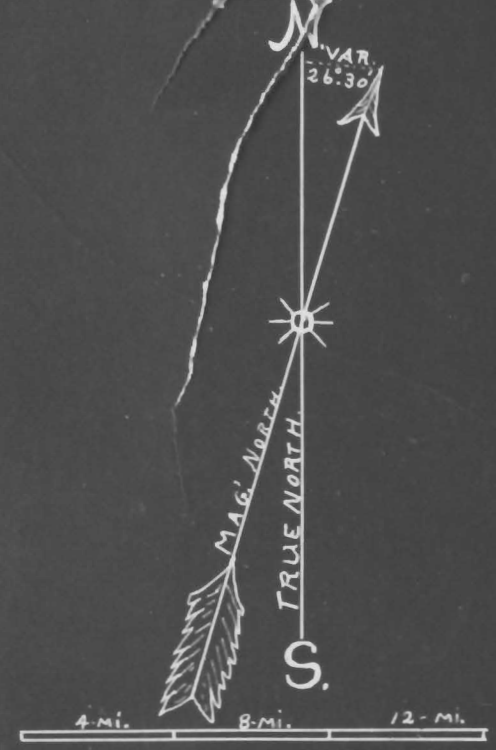




GLACIER
