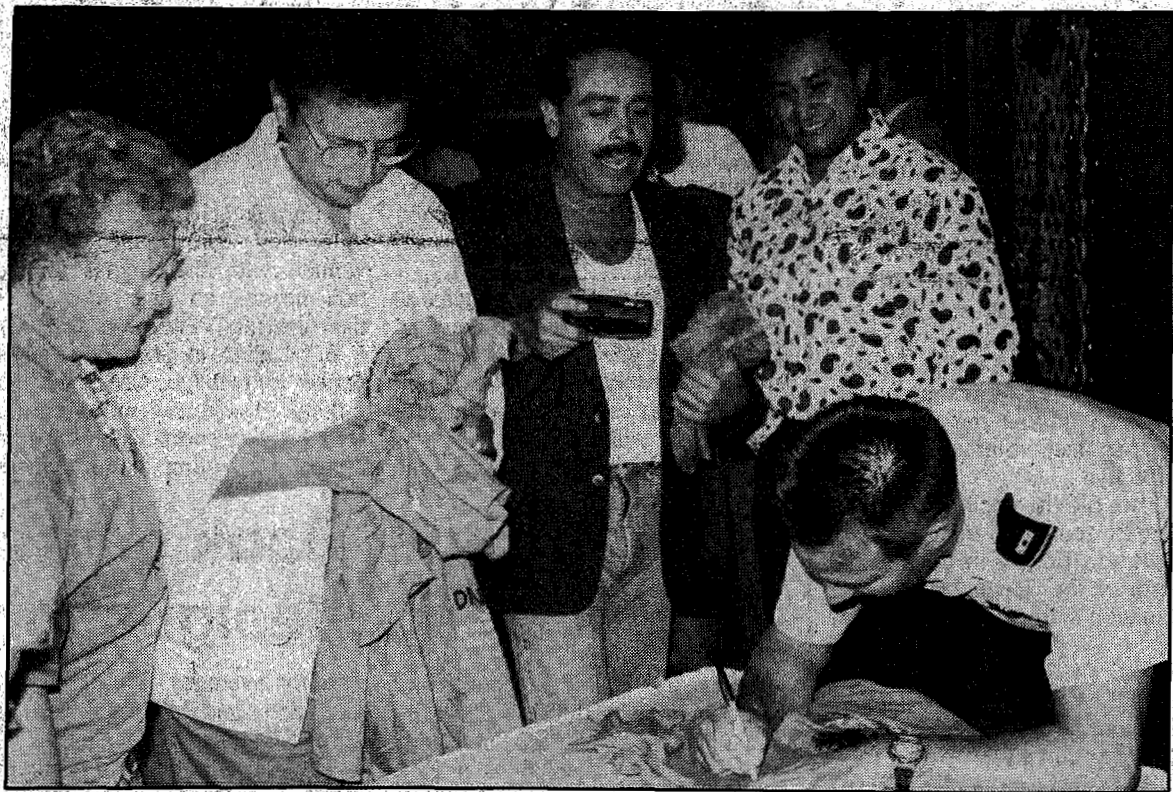




Dino-Soar veterans
