- Wedding Ceremonies are allowed on pedestrian bridges, but picnics or receptions are prohibited (Do Not Block Bridge).

COVID-19 CAPACITY RESTRICTIONS FOR OUTDOOR EVENTS

Set by the State of Colorado

(For pavilion, stage use for family, church, or group picnics, weddings)
PLEASE PRINT

On the day of your event, State COVID-19 Dial Capacity Level Restrictions must be followed as listed on the FCDPHE website <https://www.fremonthhealthdata.com/covid-dial>. The City cannot determine what level we will be at during the time of your event as our level on the dial may change due to the number of active COVID cases in the county. It is your responsibility to check our level on the dial and capacity level restrictions on the day of your event and to have no more than the number of attendees allowed for our level on the dial.

When capacity limits are expressed as both a percentage of posted capacity and a total number of people, use whichever number is fewer.

LEVEL GREEN

50% capacity or 500 people

LEVEL BLUE

50% capacity or 250 people

LEVEL YELLOW

50% capacity or 175 people

LEVEL ORANGE

25% capacity or 75 people

LEVEL RED

25% capacity or 75 people (with calculator), attended only with members of your own household and 6ft spacing between groups
